CAPITAL PROJECT REFERENDUM OF DECEMBER 12, 2006

MINUTES

The vote for appropriating the necessary funds to perform reconstruction at the Martin H. Glynn school took place at the Ichabod Crane High School Gymnasium, Valatie, NY between the hours of 8AM and 9PM.

PROPOSITION

Shall the following resolution be adopted:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Kinderhook Central School District, Columbia and Rensselaer Counties, New York is hereby authorized to (1) perform reconstruction at the Martin H. Glynn school including sitework thereat, and acquire original furnishings, services, equipment, machinery or apparatus required for the purpose of improving accessibility to the district facilities for persons with disabilities pursuant to the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1993, at a maximum cost of \$707,000, (2) to expend said sum for this purpose, (3) levy the necessary tax therefor taking into account state aid and grants received, to be levied and collected in annual installments in such years and such amounts as may be determined by the Board of Education, and (4) in anticipation of the collection of such tax, issue bonds and notes at one time or from time to time in the principal amount not to exceed \$707,000, and to levy a tax to pay the interest on said obligations when due.
