MLA Bibliography Guide

Your bibliography entries should be alphabetized by the author/editor's last name. The second line of your entries should be indented.

Book with One Author:

Author Last Name, First Name. *Title of Book*. City of Publication: Publisher, Copyright Date. Print.

Example:

McMann, Lisa. *Wake*. New York: Simon Pulse, 2008. Print.

Book with Two Authors:

Author Last Name, First Name and First Name Last Name. *Title of Book*. City of Publication: Publisher, Copyright Date. Print.

Example:

Kramer, Arthur and Paul Williams. *A Century of American Films*. New York: Watts, 2003. Print.

Book with Three or More Authors:

First Author Last Name, First Name et al. *Title of Book*. City of Publication: Publisher, Copyright Date. Print.

Example:

Smith, Mary, et. al. *How to Groom Your Large Dog Without Getting Hurt*. Kinderhook: Pet's Press, 2005. Print.

Book with an Editor:

Editor Last Name, First Name, ed. *Title of Book*. City of Publication: Publisher, Copyright Date. Print.

Example:

Miller, James, ed. *Thirteen Scary Stories*. San Francisco: Surfer's Press, 2003. Print.

Article in a Database:

Author Last Name, First Name. "Title of Article." *Title of Journal*. Volume.Issue (Year): page numbers. Title of Database. Medium of Publication. Date of Access Day, Month, Year.

Example:

Beebe, Ronald et. al. "Emerging Patterns in Transferring Assessment Practices from F2f to Online Environments." *Electronic Journal of e-Learning*. 8.1 (2004): 1-12. EBSCO. Web. 25 October 2010.

Interview:

Name of Person Interviewed Last Name, First Name Middle Name. Type of Interview (Personal Interview, Telephone Interview, Email Interview, etc.). Date of Interview Day Month Year.

Example:

Vonnegut, Kurt. Personal interview. 19 November 2009.

Online Encyclopedia Article

Author Last Name, First Name. "Title of Article." *Title of Encyclopedia*. Publisher, Copyright Date. Web. Date Accessed Day Month Year.

Example:

Kalish, Richard. "Catacombs." *World Book Student*. World Book, 2010. Web. 25 October 2010.

Print Encyclopedia or Other Reference Work:

Author Last Name, First Name. "Title of Article." *Title of Encyclopedia*. Latest Copyright Year ed. Print.

Example:

Kalish, Richard A. "Catacombs." *The World Book Encyclopedia*. 2007 ed. Print.

Print Magazine:

Author Last Name, First Name. "Title of Article." *Title of Magazine* Date of Magazine: Page Numbers. Print.

Example:

Dykstra, Monique. "Extreme Birding". *Canadian Geographic* June 2004: 129-145. Print.

Website:

Author Last Name, First Name. "Article Title." *Name of Website*. Publisher, Date of Publication Day Month Year. Web. Date you viewed it.

Example:

Deen, James, M. "World Mummies." *James M. Deen's Mummy Tombs*. James M. Deen, 28 September 2010. Web. 21 October 2010.
