ANNUAL ELECTION AND 2006-2007 BUDGET VOTE – May 16, 2006

MINUTES

The election of members of the Board of Education and the vote upon appropriating the necessary funds to met the estimated expenditures and the vote upon all propositions involving the expenditures of money, or authorizing the levy of taxes, took place at the Ichabod Crane High School Gymnasium, Valatie, NY between the hours of 8AM and 9PM.

PROPOSITION NO. 1 – BUDGET

Shall the following resolution be adopted:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Kinderhook Central School District, Columbia and Rensselaer Counties, New York be authorized to expend the total amount of \$33,901,740 during the school year, 2006-2007, and to levy the necessary tax therefor?"

PROPOSITION NO. 2 – BUS PURCHASE PROPOSAL

Shall the following resolution be adopted:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Kinderhook Central School District, Columbia and Rensselaer Counties, New York be authorized to purchase SCHOOL BUSES during the 2006-2007 school year at a total estimated cost not to exceed \$358,000 and to raise said sum or so much thereof as may be necessary, by levy of tax in annual installments on the taxable property of the District, and in anticipation of the collection of such tax, to issue obligations of the District in accordance with the Local Finance Law?

PROPOSITION NO. 3 – FRONT END LOADER

Shall the following resolution be adopted:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Kinderhook Central School District, Columbia and Rensselaer Counties, New York be authorized to purchase FRONT END LOADER during the 2006-2007 school year at a total estimated cost not to exceed \$130,000 and to raise said sum or so much thereof as may be necessary, by levy of tax in annual installments on the taxable property of the District, and in anticipation of the collection of such tax, to issue obligations of the District in accordance with the Local Finance Law?
