



Kindergarten Orientation

First Day of School

September 7, 2010

A special day is planned for the Kindergarten students on the first day of school. This day will help ease the children's transition into school with the support of their Mom and/or Dad by their side. Please plan to attend with your child. Below is an outline of the day:

- A special **bus run** will pick up each Kindergartener and his/her Mom and/or Dad at their normal bus stop. The time will be approximately between 9:15 and 9:45 am. Acclimating to the bus is an important part of the orientation; please do not drive your child to school on this day—please ride the bus with him/ her. (*Note: Siblings may **not** ride the bus under any circumstances.*)
- While at school, the children will go to their **classroom** and meet their **teacher and classmates**. Parents will also participate in classroom time.
- Children will be introduced to cafeteria procedures and have a snack in the cafeteria (no charge).
- The children take a guided tour of the building with their teacher and will have some time to play on the playground.
- Children and parents will attend a bus safety presentation conducted by the bus drivers.
- At 11:30, we will have a special bus run to return all children and parents back to their bus stop. (You will arrive at the bus stop between 11:45 and 12:30)
