

Distance Learning Offerings

- There are 800+ offerings from DL with about 60% running
- Some courses are listed as active and some non-active; Inactive is an indication that none of the schools signed up for that course for that year/semester.
- Courses that only one section is offered (Honors , AP, College Level Courses) would provide more flexibility for students to fit into their schedule by moving required classes to DL or offering the higher level course through DL
- Higher level students' schedules are locked in due to limited offerings of AP/Honors/College Level courses so electives are limited -(le) Organic Chem has been very difficult to schedule
- Provides other options for students to enroll in a course as a senior that may not typically fit in their schedule
- Teachers would have more flexibility to provide electives if some low enrollment offerings were offered through DL
- Provides more flexibility for students who attend Questar, New Visions & students in Early Admissions Programs
- Courses that typically close out (fill completely) would allow students some flexibility to enroll in another section if offered.
- Courses that are only offered every other year - provides students more chances to enroll
