

ADMINISTRATIVE ORGANIZATION

The Superintendent of Schools is the chief executive officer of the district. During his/her absence, or when he/she is unavailable, the Board of Education designates the Assistant Superintendent of School to serve as Acting Superintendent, to assume the duties and responsibilities of the Superintendent, to act in his or her behalf, and to be temporarily vested with the powers and authority of the Superintendent.

In the event that the Superintendent and the Assistant Superintendent are both unavailable, the Superintendent will designate an administrator in charge.
