

DEVELOPMENT OF REGULATIONS

The Superintendent of Schools shall be responsible for developing regulations consistent with policies of the Board of Education. In developing such regulations, the Superintendent shall, whenever feasible, seek the advice and opinions of any staff member who will be affected by the proposed regulations. The Superintendent shall give due weight to the opinions of staff, especially those offered by representatives of any groups.

The Board may review any other regulation, at its discretion, to determine whether the regulation conforms with adopted policy.

Regulations promulgated by the Superintendent shall be included in the district policy manual and disseminated in the same manner as Board Policies
