In order to be selected to participate in the festival, Julianne was required to audition on a Level Six solo and sight read a short passage for a NYSSMA judge. Only the highest scoring students in New York State are selected to perform and be part of an All State Music Ensemble. After several days of intensive rehearsals, the festival will culminate with a December concert at the Eastman School of Music in Rochester.
