Goal

To meet the needs of high school students who are struggling with hunger during the academic year.

About the Program

- Offers non-perishable, fresh, frozen, and refrigerated food options.
- Can be served on an as needed basis, or return each week.

Where Does Our Food Come From?

- We partner with the Regional Food Bank of the Northeast. Food is ordered on a bi-weekly basis and delivered to our school.
- School clubs and community members/ groups donate non-perishable foods.

Program Cost and Funding

- An average cost per bag, per student each week is \$5.63. Yearly price \$169.00/student (30 wks). Approximately \$5,070.00 yearly.
- We are completely funded by generous donations from the community and staff.
