Superintendent Presentation 2016-2017 Budget

Superintendent George Zini gave a powerpoint presentation on the 2016-2017 budget which was a 0.67% increase of the levy from last year and at the tax levy limit set by the State Education Department.

Shall the Board of Education of the Kinderhook Central School District, Columbia and Rensselaer Counties, New York be authorized to (1) acquire **four(4)** SCHOOL BUSES, at a maximum aggregate cost of **\$394,297**; (2) expend such sum for such purpose; (3) levy of the necessary tax therefore (and to pay interest thereon), to be levied and collected in annual installments in such years and in such amounts as may be determined by the Board of Education taking into account state aid; and (4) in anticipation of the collection of such tax, issuance of bonds and notes of the District at one time or from time to time in the principal amount not to exceed **\$394,297**?
