ANNUAL ELECTION AND 2015-2016 BUDGET VOTE - May 19, 2015

MINUTES

The election of members of the Board of Education and the vote upon appropriating the necessary funds to meet the estimated expenditures and the vote upon all propositions involving the expenditures of money, or authorizing the levy of taxes, took place at the Ichabod Crane High School Auditorium, Valatie, NY between the hours of 8AM and 9PM.

PROPOSITION #1 - BUDGET

Shall the Board of Education of the Kinderhook Central School District, Columbia and Rensselaer Counties, New York be authorized to expend the total amount of \$37,552,000 during the school year 2015-2016 and to levy the necessary tax therefore?

PROPOSITION #2 - BUS PURCHASE

Shall the Board of Education of the Kinderhook Central School District, Columbia and Rensselaer Counties, New York be authorized to (1) acquire four (4) SCHOOL BUSES, at a maximum aggregate cost of \$319,000; (2) expend such sum for such purpose; (3) levy of the necessary tax therefore (and to pay interest thereon), to be levied and collected in annual installments in such years and in such amounts as may be determined by the Board of Education taking into account state aid; and (4) in anticipation of the collection of such tax, issuance of bonds and notes of the District at one time or from time to time in the principal amount not to exceed \$319,000?
