AND WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Kinderhook Central School District at the Annual District Vote and Election held on May 16, 2017, was authorized by the voters of the district to expend sums in the total amount of \$ <u>39,189,544</u> during the 2017-2018 school year, and to levy the necessary tax therefor;
