Board President Anthony Welcome called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m.

MOTION NARAMORE 2ND ASCHENBRENNER

To adopt for presentation to the voters of the district, as <u>PROPOSITION #1</u>, the 2014-2015 Budget as recommended by Administration as follows:

Shall the Board of Education of the Kinderhook Central School District, Columbia and Rensselaer Counties, New York be authorized to expend the total amount of **\$35,782,506** during the school year 2014-2015 and to levy the necessary tax therefore?

MOTION CHANDLER 2ND NARAMORE

To adopt for presentation to the voters of the district, as <u>PROPOSITION #2</u>, the 2014-2015 Bus Proposal as recommended by Administration as follows:

Shall the Board of Education of the Kinderhook Central School District, Columbia and Rensselaer Counties, New York be authorized to (1) acquire **five(5)** SCHOOL BUSES, at a maximum aggregate cost of **\$372,500**; (2) expend such sum for such purpose; (3) levy of the necessary tax therefore (and to pay interest thereon), to be levied and collected in annual installments in such years and in such amounts as may be determined by the Board of Education taking into account state aid; and (4) in anticipation of the collection of such tax, issuance of bonds and notes of the District at one time or from time to time in the principal amount not to exceed **\$372,500**?

MOTION CHANDLER 2ND ASCHENBRENNER

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE KINDERHOOK CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT (the "District") that the following PROPOSITION (#4) shall be presented to the voters of the District at the annual meeting of the District:

Shall the Board of Education have an ex-officio **student member**, who shall be a student attending Ichabod Crane High School, which student member shall be entitled to sit with Board members at and participate in all public Board meetings and hearings, but shall **not** be (1) allowed to vote or attend executive sessions of the Board, and (2) entitled to receive compensation in any form for participating at Board meetings?

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the District Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to include notice of such proposition in the notice of the annual District meeting.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption. Carried, 8-0

MOTION TREFZGER 2ND RAMOS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE KINDERHOOK CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT (the "District") that the following PROPOSITION (#5) shall be presented to the voters of the District at the annual meeting of the District:

Shall the Kinderhook Central School District provide for the **registration of voters** from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm on school days at the Office of the District Clerk in the Central Office of the School District?

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the District Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to include notice of such proposition in the notice of the annual District meeting.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption. Carried, 8-0

Board President Anthony Welcome noted that the May 20 vote would also include Board member elections. Three three-year terms on the Board of Education will expire June 30, 2014. Community members interested in running for the Board of Education may contact the District Clerk for a candidate petitions. All candidate petitions must include the signatures of 34 qualified voters and are due back to the office of the District Clerk before April 21, 2014 at 5:00 p.m.
