MOTION GERKMAN 2<sup>ND</sup> NARAMORE

Resolution Calling upon the New York State Commissioner of Education and the NYS Board of Regents to Stop the Over-Reliance on Standardized Tests as a Measure of Student Performance and Principal/Teacher Effectiveness

**WHEREAS,** the Ichabod Crane Central School District is dedicated to preparing all students to meet the challenges of our future and to appreciate the value of their own lives by nurturing each individual's unique talents, instilling a desire for life-long learning, and fostering a strong spirit of community; and

**WHEREAS,** the decline in State support for public schools has forced our District to compromise our mission by reducing programs and has limited our ability to implement the new programs mandated by the State, such as the Common Core Standards, creating an uneven roll-out of the standards among school districts around the State; and

**WHEREAS,** our State's school systems have been spending increasing amounts of already scarce time, money, and energy on high-stakes standardized testing, in which student performance on standardized tests is used to make major decisions affecting individual students, educators, and schools; and

**WHEREAS**, despite the fact that research recommends the use of multiple measures to gauge student performance and teacher effectiveness, the State's growing reliance on standardized testing is adversely affecting students across all spectrums, the morale of our educators, student learning time, is narrowing the curriculum, further draining already scarce resources, and jeopardizing the rich, meaningful education our students need and deserve; and

**WHEREAS,** the federal Elementary and Secondary Education Act's testing policies fail to appropriately accommodate the unique needs of students with disabilities and English language learners in assessing their learning, resulting in test scores that do not accurately represent a true measure of the contributions of teachers and schools; and

**WHEREAS,** it is time for policymakers to reconsider the number, duration and appropriate use of standardized tests so that we can refocus our efforts on student learning;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that we call upon the Commissioner of Education, the NYS Board of Regents, and other policymakers to reexamine public school accountability systems in our State, and to develop a system based on multiple forms of assessment which does not require extensive standardized testing, more accurately reflects the broad range of student learning, and is used to support students and improve schools; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that we call upon the U.S. Congress and the Administration to overhaul the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (currently known as the "No Child Left Behind Act"), reduce federal testing mandates, promote multiple forms of evidence of student learning and school quality in accountability, and not mandate any fixed role for the use of student test scores in evaluating educators.

The Board sent a copy of this resolution to federal elected officials, state elected officials, Commissioner King, Chancellor Tisch and District Superintendent Baldwin.

# MOTION CHANDLER 2<sup>ND</sup> NARAMORE

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Schools and the Board of Education of the Ichabod Crane Central School District believe it to be the best interests of the School District and the members of the School community to not participate in the selection or implementation of a Data Dashboard Solution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Ichabod Crane Central School District upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, hereby determines not to participate in the selection or implementation of a Data Dashboard Solution and the Superintendent of Schools is hereby authorized to take all necessary steps to implement this decision in order to protect the privacy of our students and families.
