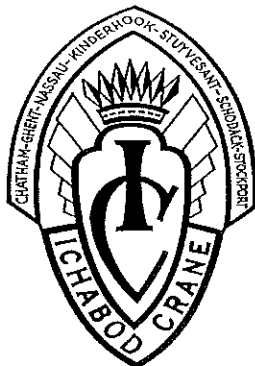

The School and Community

Ichabod Crane High School was founded in 1954 and serves the high school population for the Ichabod Crane Central School District, located twenty miles south of Albany in the Hudson River Valley. It is a rural-suburban community with a population of approximately 13,800. The district is composed of a primary school, elementary/middle school and a high school. Most of our 1,762 students reside in northern Columbia and southern Rensselaer counties.

Academic Programs

Ichabod Crane High School offers a traditional college preparatory program as well as vocational and occupational studies. All students are encouraged to supplement their academic program with a variety of electives offered in art, instrumental and vocal music, technology, English, Science, Math and Social Studies. Support services and a collaborative class setting are available for students with disabilities as approved by the district Committee on Special Education.

College Courses

Students at Ichabod Crane High School may take the following college level courses: Psychology, College Algebra, College Pre-Calculus, Statistics, English Composition, English Composition and Literature, Advanced Biology, Anatomy/Physiology, Advanced Drawing & Painting, and Advanced Ceramics & Sculpture.

Advanced Placement Courses

Advanced Placement English Literature & Composition, World History, United States History and Calculus AB are

offered to Ichabod Crane High School students. AP courses are weighted with a factor of 5 points for the purposes of calculating students' overall final average and rank.

Honors Courses

Ichabod Crane High School offers honors courses in English, Social Studies, Math and Science. Honors level courses are weighted with a factor of 5 points in computing students' overall final average and rank.

Regents Courses

Regents courses follow New York State standard curricula and are weighted with a factor of 2 points in computing students' overall final average and rank.

Graduation Requirements, Class of 2019

Members of the Class of 2019 must earn a minimum of 22 credits distributed as follows: Four units each of English and Social Studies, three units each of Mathematics and Science, one unit of Fine Art, one-half unit of Health, two units of Physical Education, and 4.5 units of elective credits. Ichabod Crane students must take a language other than English for one year.

Final Grades

Final grades for full-year courses are based on the average of four marking periods and the final exam.

Class Rank

Class Rank is computed on a 0-100 basis over seven semesters; three year graduates on a five semester basis. Five points are added to AP, honors and college level courses. Two points are added to Regents level courses. School level courses and optional electives are not weighted. *All course final averages are not weighted. Only the overall GPA and rank are based on the weight system.*
