- 1) Policy 4000, Student Learning Standards and Instructional Guidelines (revised)  
Language includes adding cursive writing instruction in grades 3 and four. \*\*\*Moved to first reading\*\*\*
- 2) Policy 2250, Board Committees (revised)  
Language to include composition and distribution of minutes to Committee Members and District Clerk within 48 hour timeline. \*\*\*Moved to first reading\*\*\*
- 3) Policy 1240, Visitors to School. \*\*\*Deferred for written legal opinion\*\*\*
- 4) Policy 2245, Student Member on the Board. \*\*\*Deferred for written legal opinion\*\*\*
- 5) Policy 8130.1, Extreme Risk Protection Orders (The “Red Flag Law”) \*\*\*Moved to first reading\*\*\*
- 6) Policy 5605, Voter Registration for Students. Changes to Election Law Section 5-507 now requires school districts to adopt a policy regarding the pre-registration of students aged 16 and/or 17 years of age. \*\*\*Moved to first reading\*\*\*
- 7) Policy 1741, Home-Schooled Students (Immunization) Home Schooled students may participate in school sponsored extra-curricular and/or co-curricular activities (with the exception of modified and interscholastic athletics) that are not open to the general public as long as they can provide either documentation of immunization to or a medical exemption for immunization from, the same communicable diseases required for entry into the public schools and under conditions. \*\*\*Moved to first reading\*\*\*
- 8) Policy 5420, Student Health Services (Immunization) Eliminates the previous religious exemption. \*\*\*Moved to first reading\*\*\*
- 9) Policy 5152, Admission of Non-Resident Students \*\*\*TABLED\*\*\*
- 10) Policy 9620, Child abuse in an Educational Setting. Sets forth specific responsibilities for certain district employees regarding reporting allegations of child abuse by district employees and volunteers and the new language reflects required changes to Chapter 363 Laws of New York. \*\*\*Moved to first reading\*\*\*
- 11) Policy 8121.1, Opioid Overdose Prevention (Naloxone administration) \*\*\*Deferred for written legal opinion\*\*\*
