


Provide Instruction in Each Student's Preferred Learning Style

FEV Tutor's Virtual Classroom Supports:

Kinesthetic Learners



Students and tutors meet in a synchronous two-way virtual classroom, interacting through a series of clickable tools and manipulatives designed to collaboratively master lesson objectives.

Kinesthetic learning tools include: pencil, highlighter, text, geometric, shapes, drag-and-drop, and symbols. Students can even personalize their experience by selecting the color, size, and designs of their choice.

Digital Communication



21st-century classrooms require typing and strong digital 4C skills to prepare students to compete in a global market. Virtual tutoring sessions provide students the opportunity to improve their digital communication skills, which simultaneously engage with academic content. **In addition to one-way audio conferencing, students can communicate with their tutor via chat messaging. At this time, our platform does not support two-way video conferencing.**

Verbal Learners



Some students are most engaged when they can speak aloud to a tutor. Students can speak directly to their tutor, if physical surroundings permit and a headset/microphone is available on their computer. **To select this feature, students can enable the microphone on their computer and press the “conference” button on the FEV Tutor platform.**

Note: this is a one-way conferencing feature, so the tutor will respond in the chat. This is mainly due to bandwidth issues.

Auditory Learners



Due to a variety of different factors, some students prefer to hear text read aloud to them.

Audio is provided on the platform using text-to-speech technology. If they are having trouble reading or engaging with the chat, students can press the text-to-speech button and the entire chat will be read aloud to them.

Our one-way conferencing feature and text-to-speech feature can be used together to support learners with diverse needs. As a best practice, many students use the one-way conferencing feature to speak directly to their tutor and then use the text-to-speech feature to support comprehension of their tutor's response in the chat.
