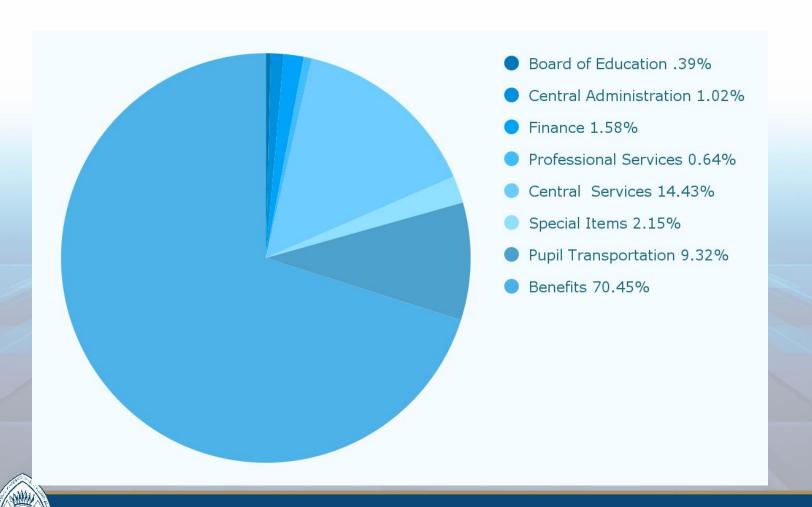

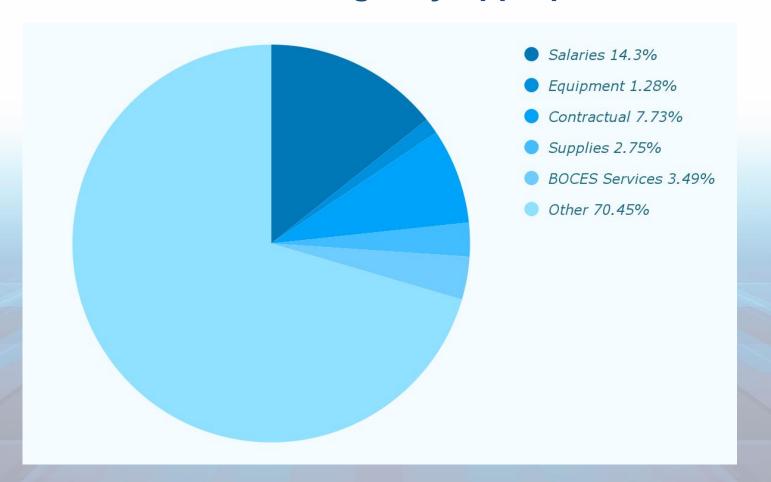
Distribution of Proposed Non-Instructional Budget

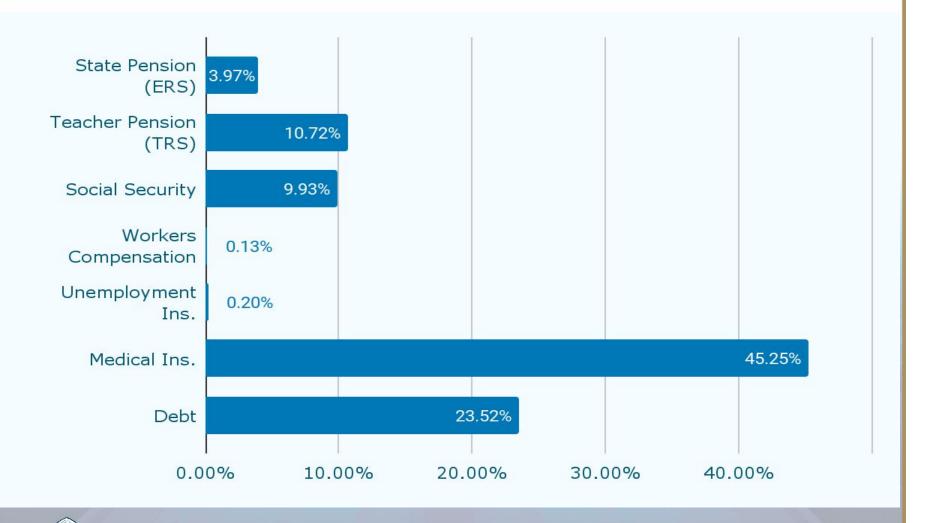

State Aid Trends: 2023-24 Proposal

- Overall State Aid has increased \$4 Million since 2019-20
- Foundation Aid: 62.5% of all State Aid. In 19-20 it was about 70%
- Expense Driven Aids have increased
- Building Aid: Has increased to 12% of aid package, in 19-20 it was
 7.2%
- Transportation Aid: Has remained fairly consistent since 19-20 at 10-11%
- BOCES Aid: Has experienced the greatest increase from 7 to 10% or over \$800k. We have in part driven up this aid with careful use of the Grant funding. By placing salaries in the grants, we have replaced them with equipment, services and tech purchases from BOCES and have utilized the 50% plus aid ratios. When the grants are complete, the salaries will slide back into the General Fund
