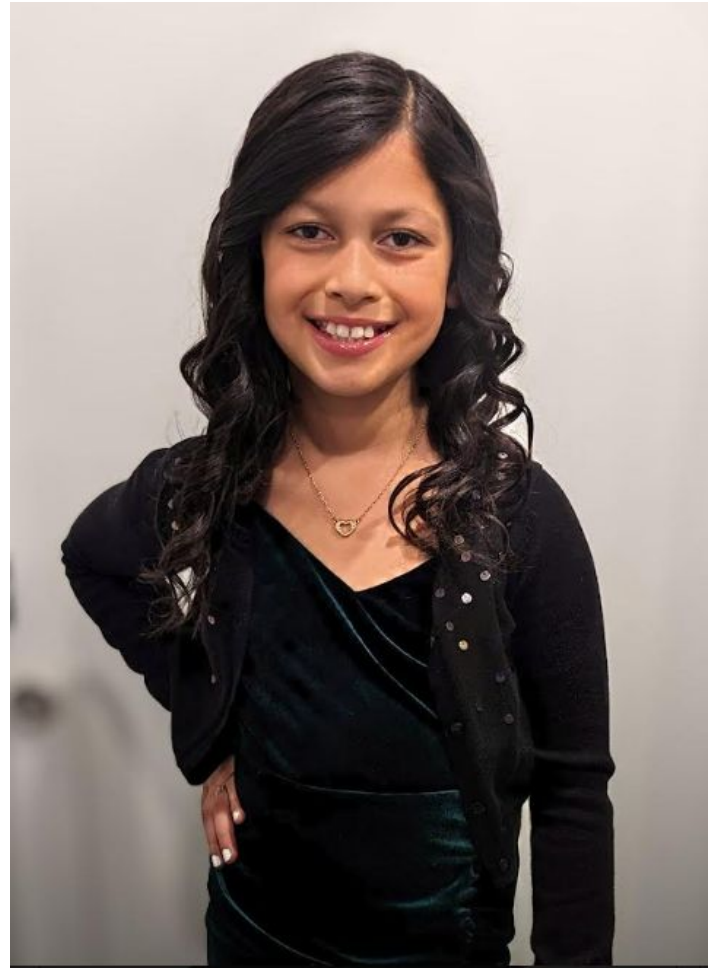
# Elayna Davis

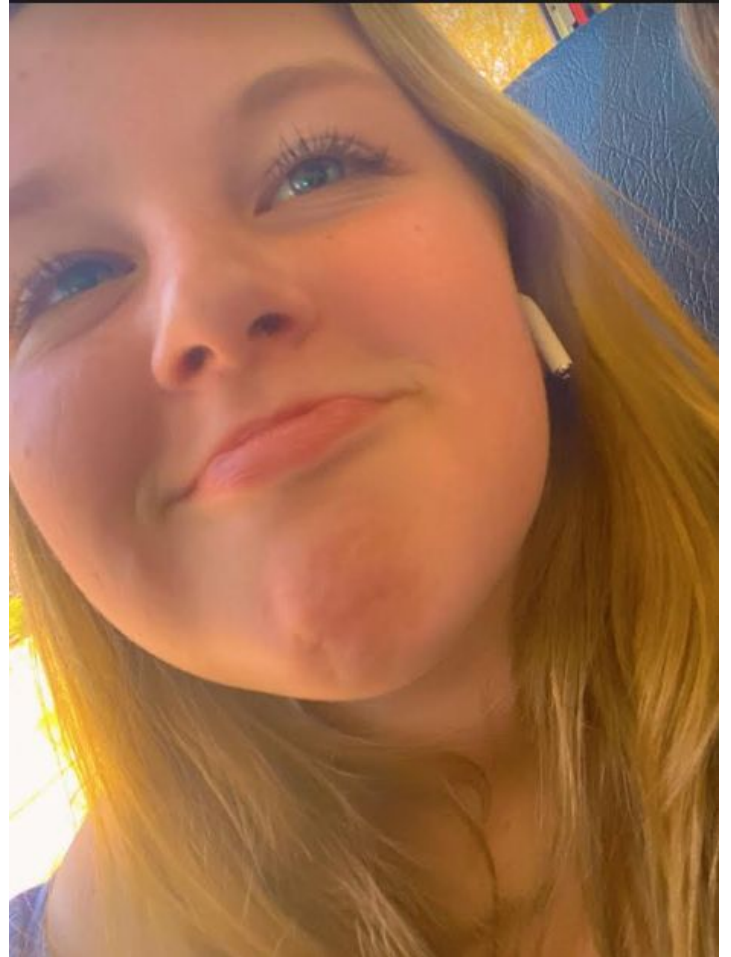
# Finn Weinrich
