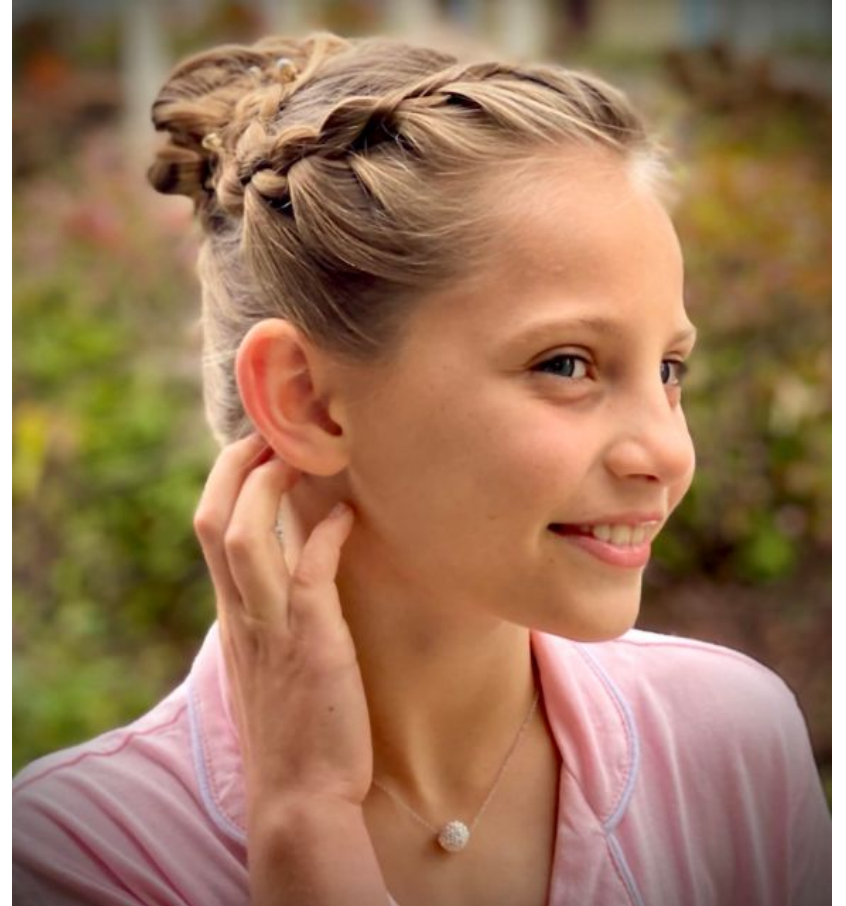
# Calvin Caldwell

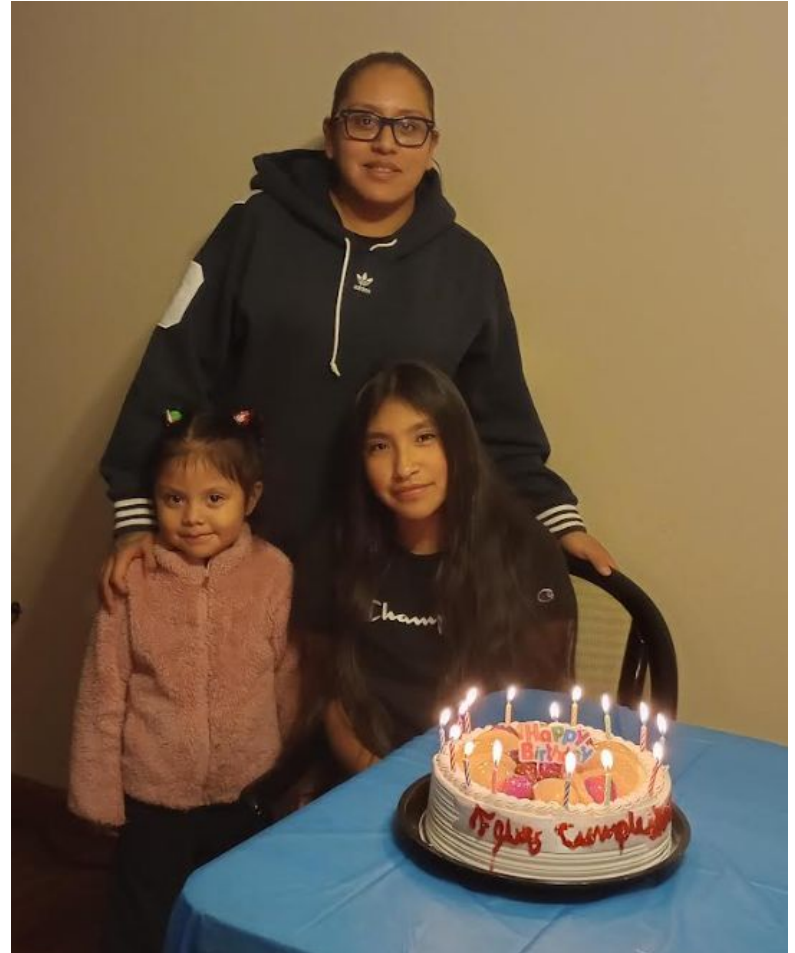
# Holland Waits
