Mayra is a helpful student who is willing to assist students around her. She does high quality work in class. She has a positive attitude in class and in the hallway.



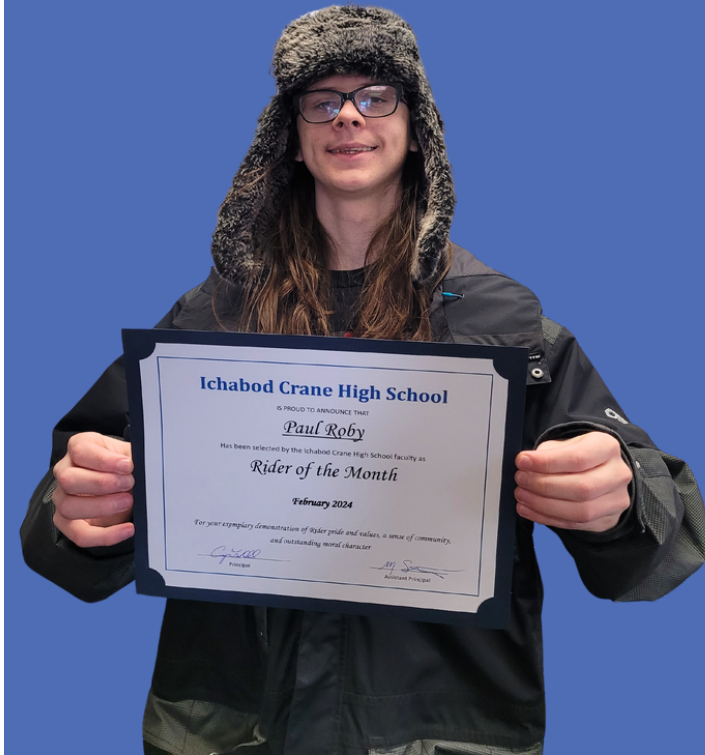
GAVIN FRICK
