

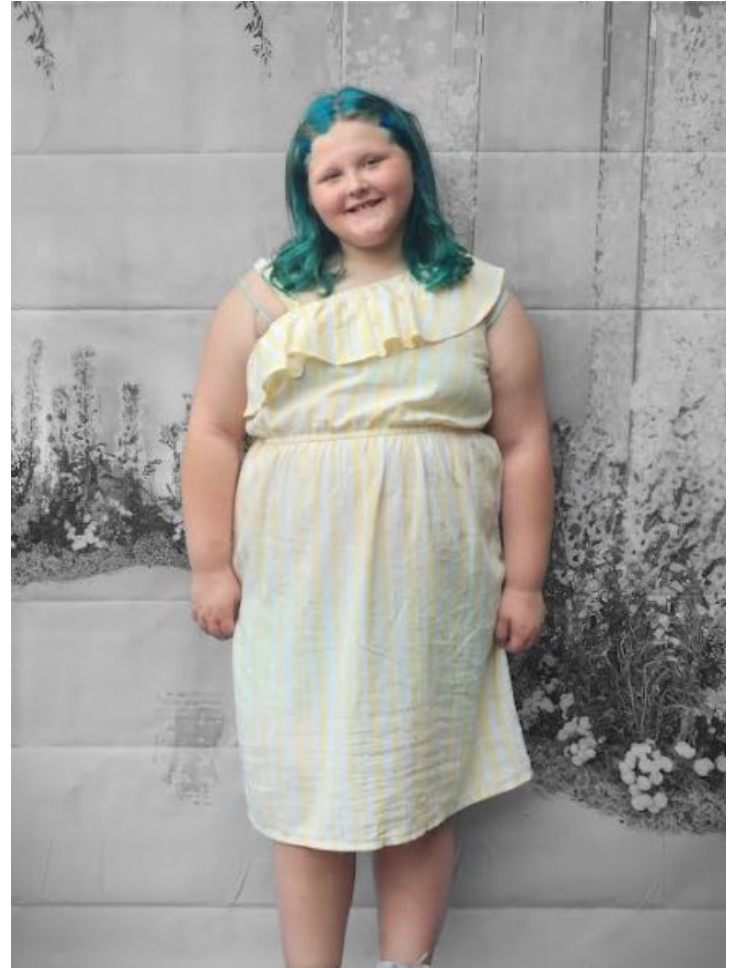
Hunter Wilson

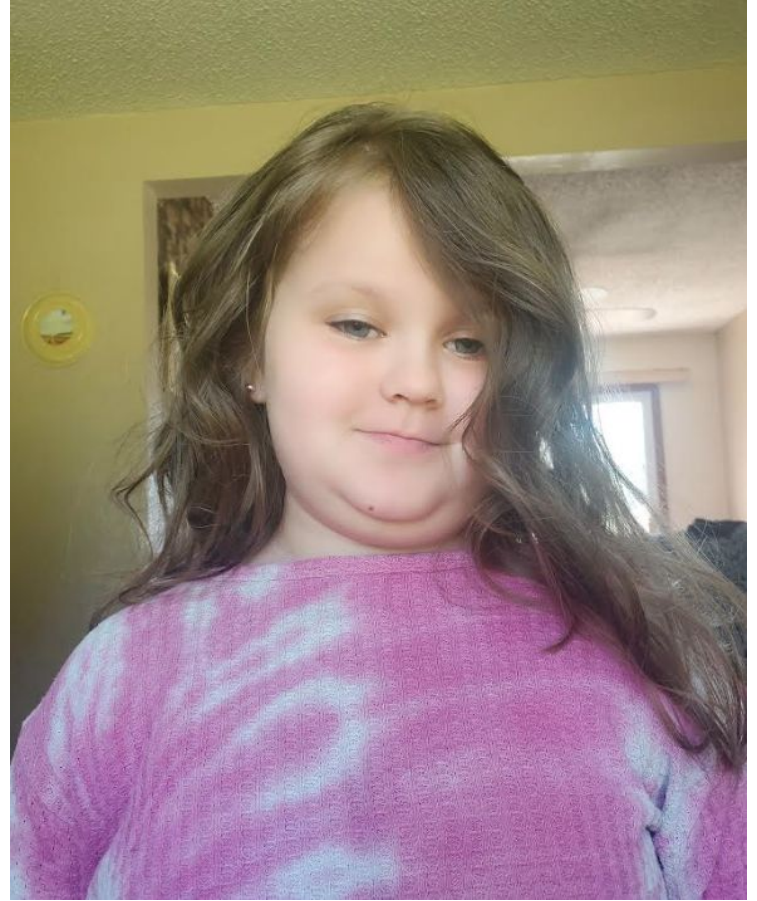
Annabelle Geddes
