WHEREAS, the DPAs are presented to school districts and/or BOCES for final execution and do not require the expenditure of funds beyond those budgeted; and
BE IT RESOLVED, Board of Education of the Ichabod Crane Central School authorizes the attorneys designated by the ROC to negotiate and approve of DPAs for software and/or technology resources; and,
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Ichabod Crane Board of Education grants the ROC and its designated attorneys the authority to negotiate the terms and conditions of DPAs and take such actions so as to effectuate the purposes and intent of this resolution.
