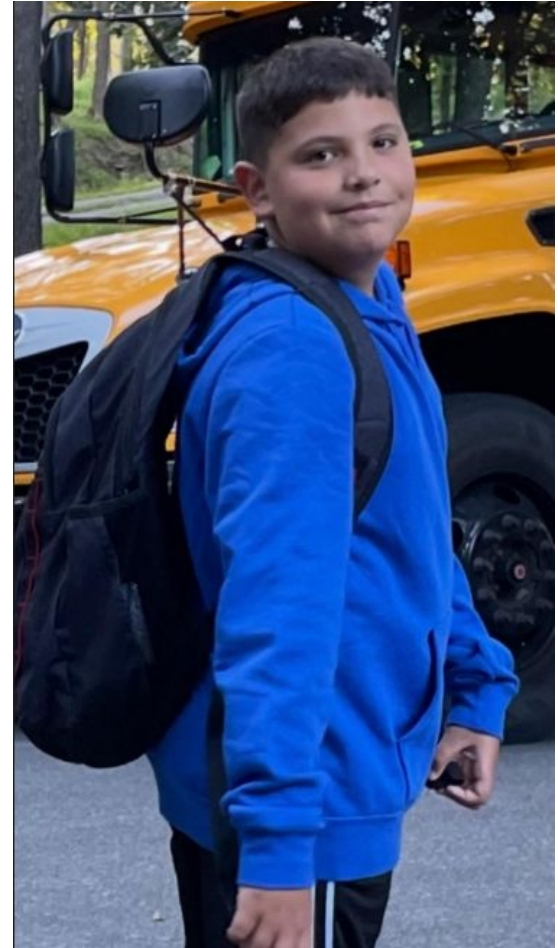
Elizabeth Hindes
