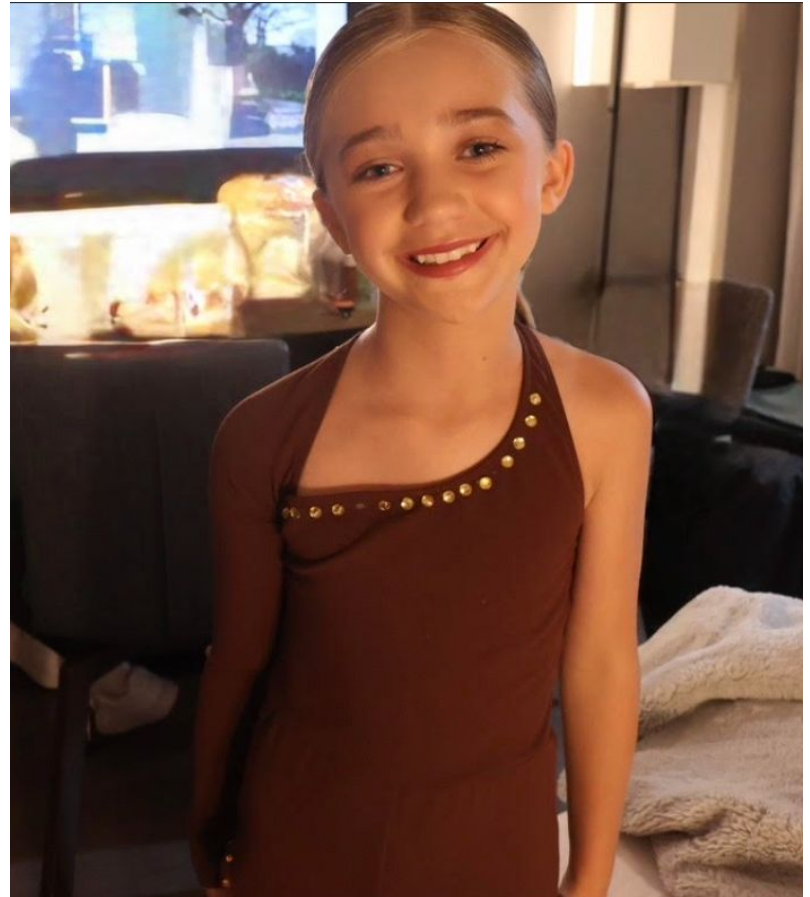


# Reagan Gildersleeve

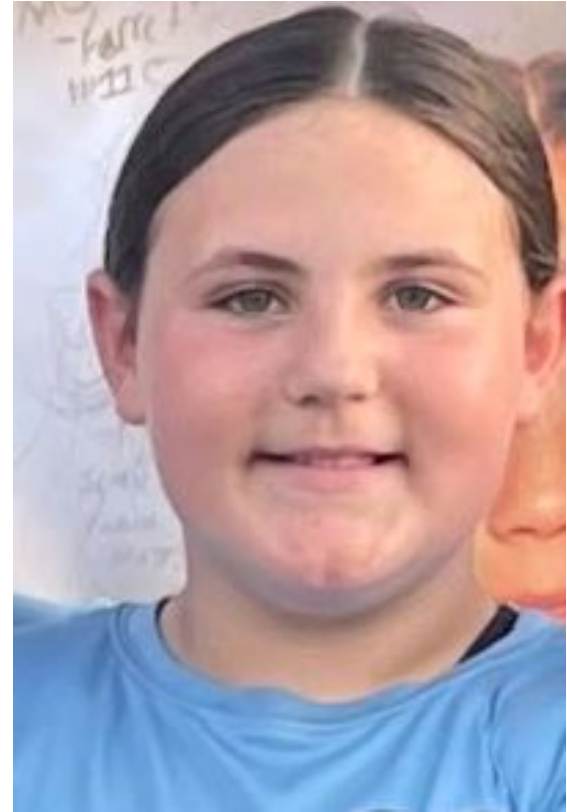
# Francisco Cipollino

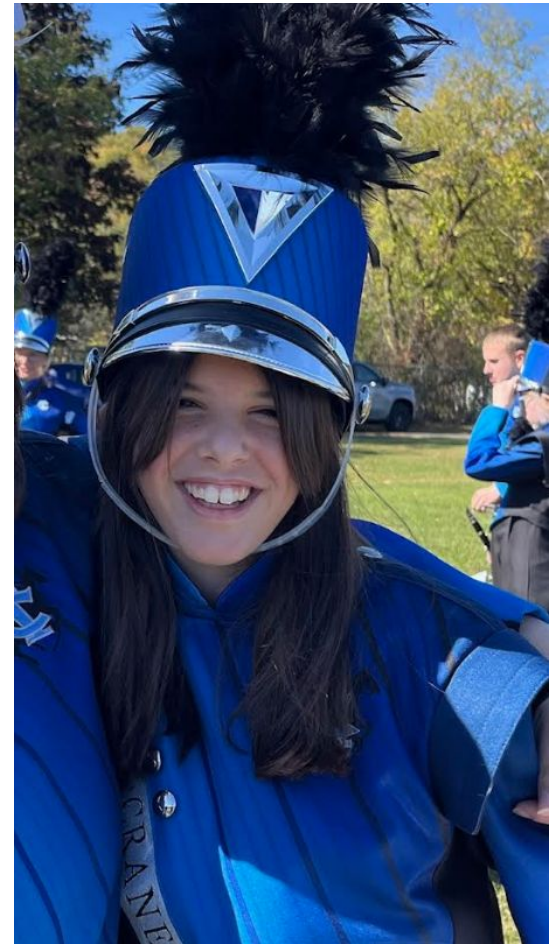
# Emma Halstead
