Graidy contributes to class discussions and is doing a great job in class. He is willing to help others and works great with his peers.



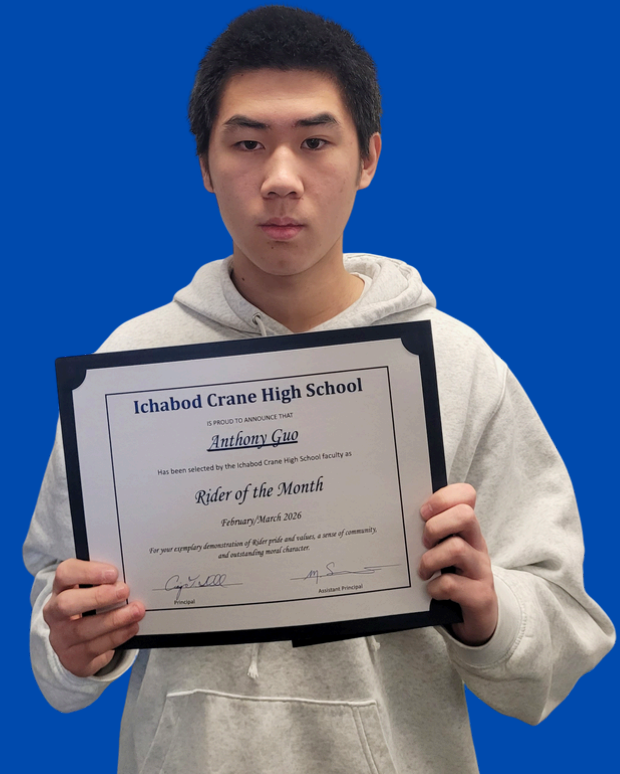
PERSAEA BOWLER
