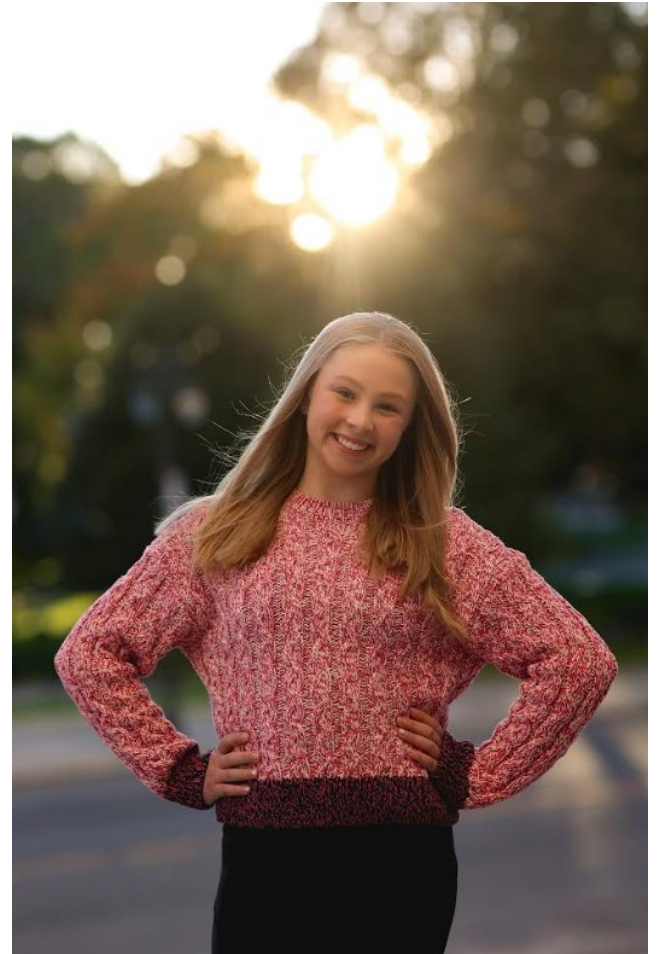
# Brooke Zoni
