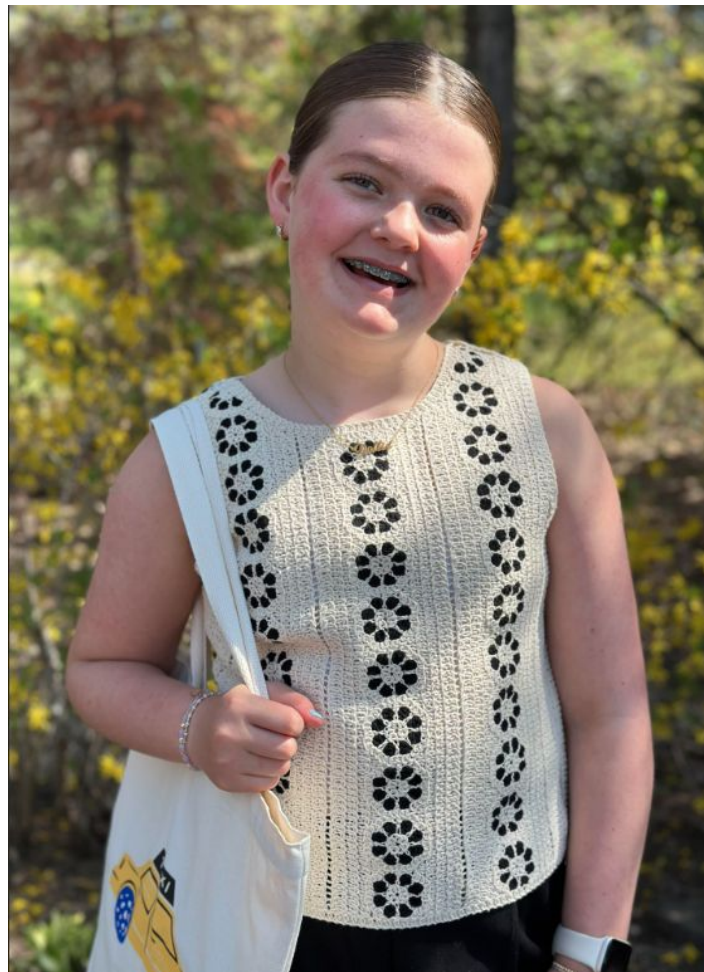
Blair Kirsch
